Gloria Smethers

Gloria is an "MK", the daughter of the late Herb and Betty Smethers who served 36 years in Kenya and Zaire with AIM. She has been working with Africa Inland Mission for 31 years as of September 2016.



Gloria first went to Congo (formerly Zaire) from 1985-1996 as a nurse. Due to political unrest AIM removed their missionaries from Zaire for a period of time. For 8 months in 1997 she assisted in the care of elderly AIM missionaries at the Retirement Center in Florida.

At that point it was obvious that she and other missionaries would not be able to return to Zaire. The Lord opened up the avenue to minister in Northern Kenya after obtaining her Kenyan RN license in 1999. The work in Northern Kenya was among a traditionally nomadic people.

Unfortunately, after almost 10 years, there was unrest in that area as well and it was targeted towards missionaries, particularly Gloria, so AIM felt it best for her to relocate. She then went to Rift Valley Academy (an MK boarding school) in Kijabe, Kenya to help the resident nurses and medical staff, and served there for a little more than three years.

Gloria writes, "Since September 2013, I have been working at AIM Retirement center in Minneola, Florida. The original property was donated to AIM in the 1930's. Fortunately the mission leadership had the vision to keep this property for a retirement center for missionaries. By the end of this year there will be at least 78 residents. I am one of 2 nurses who spend most of our time caring for the medical needs of 12 residents who live in our boarding facility on the property. I can be asked to care for medication pick up from drugstore, insurance questions, trip to get blood-work done, going to doctor appointments, or call 911 for a resident really not well. I am glad to be able to help a number of missionaries living here who had input in my life as teenager or when I was in Zaire. It is also a privilege to take the opportunities of sharing the Lord with medical staff whom I have gotten to know in the ER, doctor's office, and Walgreens while getting tasks done. I am pleased to be here, and know the Lord wants me here just as much as when HE led me to Rethy, Zaire in 1985, to Kalacha, Kenya in 1999, to RVA, Kenya in 2009. THE LORD IS GOOD ALL THE TIME!!! Thanks to everyone who continues to pray, support and write to me. I appreciate your sacrifice towards my support and don't take it lightly. It means a great deal to me. THANKS SO MUCH!!! "
