## CHRIS &amp; DEB BOWERS

**C**hris Bowers did his Bible, aircraft maintenance and flight training through Moody Bible Institute. He joined Wycliffe Bible Translators, and moved to Papua New Guinea at the end of 2004 to fly for the Bible translators and other missionaries there. In 2006, Deb arrived from Australia to teach at the mission school, and they met when Chris flew her up to the mission center. They were married in April 2009.

Both Chris and Deb joined Wycliffe Bible Translators out of a strong desire to be a part of enabling people everywhere to have access to God's Word in the language they understand. Living in Papua New Guinea and serving the translators there has been a great privilege as they have seen first hand the work God is doing there. Chris and Deb have seen the effects of many years of mission work from people receiving newly translated scriptures in their own language for the very first time, to changing the lives of people like Sivini (the previously greatly feared warlord) and many other similar stories.

In August of 2012, they welcomed daughter Katelyn into their family. Then in October 2012, Chris and Deb moved (with 6 week old Katelyn) to Spokane WA where Chris is now serving at Moody Aviation. Moody Bible Institute has a partnership with various mission aviation programs to provide field experienced pilots to instruct the students who are training for mission aviation. Chris and Deb remain members of Wycliffe Bible Translators, and are currently fulfilling Wycliffe's commitment to provide an instructor at Moody Aviation. Though at times they miss serving in Papua New Guinea, it is exciting to see the opportunities Chris has to pass on his experience and to replace himself many times over in these new pilots heading all over the world to serve Christ through mission aviation. Chris and Deb are still living on support through Wycliffe, and would greatly appreciate your prayers and financial partnership.
