We are **Ed and Valerie Schubert, your E.C. Missionaries to Honduras**. In July 2001, God transplanted our family from our thriving, family-owned dairy farm located in northern Illinois to the rugged mountains of the tiny, Central American nation of Honduras, where, for the past nineteen years, we have been actively serving Christ and the precious people of Honduras.

We have two biological sons, six spiritual daughters and one adopted daughter, totaling nine incredible children whom God has gifted to us! Only our youngest daughter is still at home with us, completing her high school education in a home school setting.

We serve in executive leadership and on the board of directors for **Fundación Casa de Luz** (*House of Light Foundation*). It is our distinct pleasure to mentor and direct a multi-national ministry team comprised of both Honduran and North American leaders. Our ministry, Casa de Luz, is dedicated to transforming the lives of at-risk children, teens and families with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Because eternity matters, we commit each day to live missionally and intentionally, while serving in joy and humility for the glory of Jesus Christ, our Savior and Lord. We carry the life-changing message of Hope and the immense Love of Jesus to the children, teens and families of Honduras through a wide variety of ministry avenues. Since God has created mankind with spiritual, emotional and physical capacities it is

our belief that a well-rounded missionary focus will minister to the needs of each of these three areas in the lives of those served.

Here is a brief description of a few of the ways we share Christ with at-risk children, teens and families in the nation of Honduras. *(All ministry services are provided completely free of charge.)*

- **Feeding Programs:** Physical and nutritional needs are met through our ministry feeding programs. Each year we serve over **48,000 hot meals** to children and teens.
- **Inner-City Community Ministry Center:** Located in the capital city of Tegucigalpa, this branch of our ministry provides on-site care for **65 children**, ages 2 to 7 years, living in abject poverty and at-risk situations. Academic tutoring, art, music, spiritual development, evangelism, medical and dental care, and daily child care are integral components of our inner-city mission.
- **Rural Campus Community Ministry Center:** Located on a rural mountain plateau, we minister to **150 at-risk children and teens** ages 3 to 15 years of age who are living in situations of extreme poverty. Spiritual development classes, evangelism, art, music, life-mentoring, and academic tutoring are incorporated into our rural campus mission.
- **Christian Counseling, Trauma Therapy & Academic Evaluations:** We offer a wide variety of opportunities for women, children and teens, in emotional or spiritual need, to receive counsel, encouragement, healing and wholeness in Christ. We have a Christian psychologist who serves with us full-time to offer professional services, as well as academic evaluations to assist in diagnosing learning challenges or trauma-related delays.
- **Parental Training:** At both of our ministry sites we consistently provide life-coaching and formal parental training for all of the moms and dads of our Casa de Luz children.
- **National Conferences & Leadership Training for Honduran Nationals:** We plan, host, coordinate and present conferences, leadership training, and educational opportunities at the national and local level. Topics include: Trauma-Competent Care Givers, Prevention of Childhood Sexual Abuse, Justice Ministry, Health and Nutrition, Advocacy training for children and teens, and Biblical training on how to assist the emotionally wounded.
- **Young Adult Internship Program:** We invite young men and women to spend 3 to 12 months with us serving as missionary interns. The goal of this ministry program is to introduce missionary life and service to the up-and-coming generation of leaders.

- **Short-Term Mission Opportunities:** Visitors, ministry partners and donors are invited and encouraged to serve along side us for a week or more on one of our Short-Term Volunteer PERSPECTIVE teams.
