JAPAN

nown as "The Land of the Rising Sun," Japan is comprised of over 3,000 mountainous islands. The capital city of Tokyo currently ranks as one of the largest metropolitan areas in the world with over 30 million inhabitants living in greater Tokyo.

Though rich economically, Japan is one of the most spiritually bankrupt areas of the world. About 84% of Japan's population follow the rules of Buddhism or Shintoism; however close to 80% of the total population claim no personal connection to their religious practices at all. More than 67% of mid-sized towns do not have a single church, and there are still rural areas that have never been introduced to the gospel.

Recognizing the need to reach out to a hurting culture, the Evangelical Congregational Church strives to be the face of Christ in a place where 99% of the population is non-Christian. Currently, the EC Church of Japan consists of three congregations and one church plant in the greater Tokyo area, with an average morning worship attendance of over 100 people. They are Kyodo Grace Church (founded by late Rev. Dr. John Masuda and now pastored by Rev. Sudo), Sagamihara Grace Chapel (pastored by Rev. Nobuo Abe, field leader), Kobuchi Mission Church (pastored by Mr. Arita, lay preacher), and Fuchinobe church plant, pastored

by Rev. Tomoyuki and Jessica Abe.

After the major earthquake and ensuing tsunami in 2011 that devastated the northeastern coast of Japan, it was Christian agencies that responded first with food and aid. The EC Church-USA contributed \$60,000 to the recovery effort. Our EC churches in Japan used the money to go into the affected areas, bringing food and hope to people who had none. Rev. Nobuo Abe and a group of evangelical pastors continue to minister to that decimated area.



Global Ministries has committed to help Tomoyuki and Jessica by underwriting \$1000 monthly of their support to help them get established in their church plant. Can you help? We do not send any other support to our Japanese churches, but we want to see the Good News spread in this strategically placed country. Think what a powerhouse Japan could be for Gospel if there would be a great spiritual awakening in that land! Please be in prayer for our work in Japan, and contact the GMC office if you can help to support it financially. Domo Arigato!
