LIBERIA

Liberia, Africa's oldest republic, was devastated by civil war in the 1990's that lasted over a decade. It is estimated that over a quarter of a million people were killed, while thousands more fled to neighboring countries. Just when the country was beginning to get back on its feet, it was nailed with another disaster, this time a medical

one. The deadly Ebola virus cut a large swath through the Liberian population, killing over 11,000 people. It took three years to eradicate the deadly disease.

Through war, disease and other crises, the EC Church of Liberia has been the hands and feet of Christ to its neighbors. After the civil war, the EC Church leadership arranged for families to care for many of the children left orphaned by the war. They also set up rehabilitation centers for some of the child soldiers, young boys who were kidnapped, given drugs and guns, and told to kill. Then President Ellen Johnson Sirleaf commended the leadership of the EC Church for their part in the recovery of the war torn nation.

Both during and after the Ebola epidemic, the EC Church of Liberia has been active in working with the communities around EC churches. The leadership taught people how to clean affected areas as well as protect themselves when working with infected people. EC Church-USA sent monies that were used to buy bleach and other cleaning agents to help out.

Current bishop Rev. Abraham Powell has started a literacy initiative for the Bassa speaking communities, of which most of our EC churches are comprised. Because so much of the infrastructure of Liberia was destroyed during the civil war, there is an entire generation that has not had the opportunity to go to school. Rev. Powell's vision is to train teachers who will then go out and begin literacy classes in our EC churches, using the Bassa bible as a text book. In this way, people will not only learn to read, they will learn by reading God's Word.

The Liberian EC churches recently held their annual conference, and we are excited to hear what other initiatives they hope to put into place to reach Liberia for Christ. Although the country is nominally Christian, Islam and other religions are making inroads into Liberia. Please keep Rev. Powell and his leadership team, as well as our churches there, in prayer.
