### YOU'RE THE MAN!

hroughout the scriptures, the name of King David is revered as a 'man after God's own heart.' God even chose to have the Messiah, His only son, be born into David's lineage as a way of showing His love for David.

Yet David was far from perfect. II Samuel 11 recounts the tale of David's adultery with Bathsheba. When his plan to cover his tracks didn't work, David resorted to murder, then took Bathsheba as a wife. Nathan the prophet came to David and told him a story of how a wealthy man stole a poor man's only sheep to entertain guests. David's anger was palpable; 'Tell me who did this and he will be punished' he seethed to Nathan. The prophet looked the king right in the eye and said "You are the man!" At once, David understood what Nathan meant; his sin had not escaped the notice of Jehovah. As a result, his infant son paid the price for his father's guilt. Not a very good example of fatherhood! But David repented and sought God's forgiveness. He went on to become one of Israel's greatest kings.

The importance of the role a father plays in the lives of his children can't be overestimated. Our society is seeing more and more children growing up with absentee fathers, so they have no role model on how to be good parents themselves, especially young men. As we celebrate Father's Day this month, encourage the men you know to be strong spiritual leaders in their families, and to train up their sons and daughters to know the Lord. One of the best gifts a father can pass on to his children is that of a strong Christian heritage to help them navigate life. Pray that they will 'be the man' after God's own heart, as David was long ago.
