Psychologists will tell you that one of the greatest needs in man is the need at the end of life to feel that you have accomplished something. In my recent preaching through the book of Titus, the Apostle Paul encourages this young minister in the faith to share with the believers in Crete to remember where they came from, what God has done for them and then to **do** good works. Turnaround begins when we can look correctly at the past, learn from our mistakes, no longer allow them to defeat us and then embrace all that God has done for us. This is good but we are still not ready to serve.

In chapter 3 of Titus he tells them two important prerequisites to serving: (1) submitting to authorities over us; (2) walking in obedience to God's word. *(Titus 3:1) Remind them to be subject to rulers, to authorities, to be obedient, to be ready for every good deed,...*
