News from Benefits Corporation /Compensation Committee

- **The Pastoral Compensation Forms Committee (PCFC)**, a temporary subcommittee of the Compensation Committee, was established to attempt to simplify the current forms used for Pastoral Compensation. Before that work can be undertaken we need some insight at the local church level on Pastoral Compensation. **We will not ask you to change your current payroll practices.** Our goal is to simplify and bring clarity to the Pastoral Compensation process.

A short (10 question) survey can be found on www.eccenter.com under Pastoral Compensation. Pastors, treasurers, lay delegates, ministry council chairs, etc. are encouraged to complete the survey. Multiple surveys from individual churches is OK. This survey is not designed to be terribly accurate but to get a general understanding of Pastoral Compensation at the local church. The survey is anonymous and will be available until June 30, 2011.



News from Loan & Investment Committee

- Effective July 1, 2011 the interest rate on Investment Pool loans will be reduced from 5.25% to 4.75%. Each debtor church will be receiving a new loan amortization schedule in the mail shortly. If you have already paid your July payment we can either refund the payment difference or apply the extra payment to outstanding principal. If you would like a refund contact Shirley Long at the E.C. Church Center (1-800-866-7581). If you do not request a refund we will apply the extra payment to outstanding loan principal. You may wait until your new loan amortization schedule is received before making your July payment. Please remember that Interest Pool loans have a variable interest rate and the interest rate may increase in the future. The rate on the Conference Pool loans will remain at 5%.
- Also, the interest rate paid on investment certificates will be reduced to 2.75% from 3.25% effective on July 1, 2011. A notice stating the rate change will be mailed to all certificate holders with the June 30 interest checks.
