

David Hershey grew up in Trinity EC Church in Manheim and is forever grateful for the ministry of that community in his life. Dave first got involved in campus ministry with Christian Student Fellowship (CSF) as a student at Penn State University.

CSF exists on the campus to be a place for students to find Christian community. CSF welcomes all people providing a place for growth for believers while in college and a place for honest questions from those outside the faith. CSF at Penn State Berks is a chapter of the Christian Student Foundation of PA (CSFPA). In 2016, Dave took on the role of Staff Development Director with CSFPA. This new role is now half of his work, with the other half continuing to be leading CSF on campus.
