- Labor Prayer Force/ an on call prayer group that prays for mothers while they are in labor.

I recently learned of a church in South Carolina that had a well developed prayer strategy for their local church. I was so impressed with what I read that I decided to share it with our HeartCry readership.

Lexington Baptist Church has their prayer ministry divided into several key areas:

1. Community and Church Prayer Ministries

- 24 hour prayer chain for the ministries of the church
- A prayer walking ministry/small group on site praying in the community
- Ministers Prayer Partners/a once a month prayer ministry toward local pastors
- Moms in Touch Group/mothers meeting one hour a week to pray for local schools
- Children's Prayer Ministry/ a group dedicated to praying for the children and youth of the church and community
- Open Door Prayer Room/open daily at the church

2. Global and National Prayer Ministries

- Missions Prayer Team/ A group that prays for short term missions teams and missionary efforts around the world.
- Global Missions Prayer Ministry/ A prayer team that prays for the church's supported missionaries and partnerships.
- Prayer for Revival and Spiritual Awakening
