Minister:

If so, answer: I WILL TO THE BEST OF MY ABILITY.

Minister:

Will you humbly accept direction from those placed in authority over you and will you willingly serve your church in any way in which God may call you to do so?

If so, answer: I WILL.

Minister:

Will you attend the regular meetings of the _____ (*Sunday School, Christian Education*) Board unless prevented by a reason you can conscientiously present to the Lord?

If so, answer: I WILL.
