EC CHURCH OF MEXICO

 he EC Church of Mexico developed out of the work of the late Mae Royer, who started an orphanage in northern Mexico. Some of the boys grew to become men called of God to minister to their own people.

Since those humble beginnings so long ago, the EC work in Mexico has grown to 11 local congregations. Under the leadership of the current field director, Rev. Elias Martinez Osorio, the church has seen new vision and growth. Even though the majority of our Mexican EC churches are among disadvantaged people, they have looked beyond themselves and are doing outreach to evangelize surrounding states. Elias has led teams to minister in Vera Cruz and plans to expand that outreach to San Luis Potosi. These are very poor areas, where the people are nominally Christian but in truth don't know the name of Christ.

Also, in order to promote a missionary heart in the children, a program called IGLEKIDS was created. So far they have taken the kids on missionary adventures in various countries such as India, China, Uganda, Qatar, North Korea, Morocco, UAE, Somalia, and Colombia. The children learn about these countries and their



need to learn who Jesus is.

The EC Church of Mexico is in the process of developing the structure that will allow them to apply to be their own National Conference, hopefully in 2015. Please keep Rev. Martinez and the current leadership of our EC Mexican churches in prayer. They are still dealing with the aftermath of a culture of fear generated by the drug cartels. Pray for their personal safety, and that God would open doors and hearts so His Word can be firmly rooted in northern Mexico.
