### Randy & Chrisanne Amberman, New Mexico; World Gospel Mission

Randy and Chrisanne serve under World Gospel Mission on the American Indian field. They live in Kirtland, NM, just a mile off the Navajo reservation. Chris directs a Christian afterschool program that serves all the schools in Kirtland, having kids from kindergarten all the way through high school. Many of the children who come (mostly Navajo) do not have any church background. They host several family events throughout the year to give them a chance to get acquainted with the

whole family. They are also very active in the community of Kirtland, having started a women's group, a pastors' group, and most recently being involved in the creation of a Community Resource Center. They are part of a house church called Freedom of Nations. The Navajo Nation is ripe unto harvest, and they pray for more workers to enter the field.

### EC Church of Nepal (ECCN) Rev. Th. & Mercy Janga

The Evangelical Congregational Church of India began the EC mission outreach to eastern Nepal resulting in the planting of ten churches. In June, 2003 the churches elected a leadership team of five people to lead the new conference of the EC Church, and a church center was established at Dharan, in eastern Nepal. In January 2009 the ECCN became its own international conference with Rev. Th. Janga leading them.

ECCN is meeting the spiritual and physical needs of this nation through the planting of local churches,

intentional discipleship, leadership training, and a variety of hands-on ministries that meet the physical needs of orphans, widows and families.
