Singson has increased his efforts to get to churches and pastors for the sake of encouragement as they still struggle with the effects of Covid on the community, are suffering from low morale, and are in need of delivery of necessary materials, training supplies and food subsistence for the efforts to reach surrounding communities with the Gospel of Christ, not the least of which is to bring hope and encouragement to those needing it most.

As you can see from the picture to the right, the current office vehicle (red) for the ECCI is very inadequate.

It's our prayer that through the generosity and the support from the EC Church USA, the GMC will be able to provide a new all-terrain vehicle (white) for our fellow ministers in India. This campaign will run through May's EC National Conference at Messiah University.
