I SURRENDER SOME

he other week we sang the old hymn "I Surrender All" during the morning worship service. Anyone over the age of 40 who grew up in an evangelical church is probably familiar with the words; "All to Jesus I surrender, All to Him I gladly give; .." The chorus states, "I surrender all, I surrender all. All to Thee, my blessed Savior, I surrender all."*

We sing the words with gusto, but do we mean them? Are we really willing to give everything to Christ – our lives, our families, our possessions, our money? Most of us don't really understand what it means to live sacrificially. The EC Church of Nepal, which is made up of and ministers to some of the poorest people in Asia, gathered an offering of \$500 to present to the EC Church of Liberia after hearing about the suffering of their brothers and sisters in Christ in that country. By contrast, people in the USA spend more on their pets than they give to charity. People in Nepal, where one-third of the population live on less than \$1 a day, gave at a greater rate than people living in one of the wealthiest countries on earth. What's wrong with this picture?!!

Global Ministries depends on two offerings a year to help our brothers and sisters in our international church conferences, as well as cover the costs of our printing, postage, staff salaries, etc. This month, on March 11th, the Self Denial offering will be taken. Please prayerfully consider what it means to give sacrificially so that God's work can go forward. How much can you surrender?
