### NEPAL

he kingdom of Nepal is the world's only Hindu kingdom; however, the constitution guarantees some religious freedom. People can choose their faith, but it is illegal to convert others. An isolated mountainous land, containing 8 of the 10 highest mountains in the world, Nepal is just slightly larger than Pennsylvania and New Jersey combined. The 27,000,000 people represent approximately 95 people groups, but caste is more crucial socially than ethnicity. The capital city of Katmandu has 1,500,000 people.

The main livelihood of the people is from subsistence agriculture, but the chief foreign exchange is earned through tourism. While 75% of the population is Hindu, Buddhists are also well represented at 16%. An estimated 450,000 people are Christians (about 2%). The first group of Christians was formed in



1959. At the climax of persecution in 1990, Christians numbered about 200,000.

The EC Church of India began the EC mission outreach to eastern Nepal, resulting in the planting of 13 churches. We officially inaugurated the EC Church of Nepal in June, 2003. In addition to 13 churches, there are several church plants and a village school being operated by ECCN.

In June, 2003 the churches elected a leadership team of five people to lead this new field of the EC Church, and a church center was established at Dharan, in eastern Nepal. In January 2009 the EC church of Nepal became its own international field. **The field superintendent is the Rev. T. Janga**. Rev. Janga and his wife Mercy care for a number of orphans as well as their own boys at Mercy Home, the orphanage that the EC Church of Nepal has established.

In preparation for one day becoming a national conference, Rev. Janga has led his churches to begin to take on some of their pastors' salaries, as well as tithe to the conference in order to help defray costs.
