## Worthy of Their Wages

ome people may wonder why we give an honorarium to missionary speakers when we already send them regular support. Recently several of our E.C. missionaries who have gone out speaking while on furlough in the USA, have told me in private that some of the churches where they have spoken have not offered any honorarium, not even gas money. The perception seemed to be that missionaries are already 'paid', so there doesn't need to be any compensation offered.

Please allow me to correct this misperception. Our missionaries have to raise all their support plus ministry funds that are needed for them to perform on their fields. In addition, all our missionaries serve under non-denominational mission agencies, which charge between 10-25% of the gross support income to cover the agency's operating costs. In addition to all the taxes and health insurance that we all pay, those missionaries serving on foreign fields also have to have monies set aside for taxes that are paid to the host country, and extradition monies (in case they need to leave the country in a hurry.) All this means that the figure you may see for a missionary's monthly support level is not what they receive; often they only get about half of that total income.

When missionaries come off the field for furlough, they often find their budgets stretched while living in the USA due to the higher cost of living. This means having to pay for the extra gas, meals and possible housing to get to a speaking engagement can cause a hardship if there is no love gift offered. None have told me that they wouldn't accept an engagement due to lack of funds, but it is a factor that is taken into consideration.

Even if the missionary speaker is one whom your church supports, please consider giving them an honorarium to help with the expenses of travel. Consider putting out an offering plate and asking for a love gift to help with any expenses that might be over what you've budgeted. Including a pot luck meal before or after the service, or inviting the missionary family to a meal is an additional way of showing appreciation.

The apostle Paul, in his first letter to Timothy, tells him that 'the workers are worth their wages.' (I Timothy 5:18b) This is in reference to the elders of the church, but also applies to our missionaries. Most could be earning a lot more in secular jobs, but have chosen to follow God's calling to take the Gospel to all the earth. Let's help them, not hinder them, in that process. Thank you.

"The elders who direct the affairs of the church well are worthy of double honor, especially those whose work it preaching and teaching. For the Scripture says, "Do not muzzle the ox while it is treading out the grain," and "The worker is deserves his wages." I TIMOTHY 5:17-18
