was at Dicks Sporting Goods looking at things in the camping section. A lot of things have changed in camping over the years, but I noticed that three basic essentials are still available - **Tents, compasses, and maps**. As we begin our 7-month sabbatical (June 14 to Jan. 14) we are in an uncharted wilderness. We have never been this way before in our 35 years of ministry. Before we have always had a very clear idea of what we were going back to do. We have successfully completed our ministries as the Director of Field Ministries for ECM and our leadership in the church plant in Madrid. We are now in anticipation of God unveiling his next assignment for us. In our uncertainty, we are going to God to get our guidance and putting our trust in the Lord

as the verse encourages us to do. The concept of "trust" is the same idea of putting oneself in a safe protected space and allowing God to minister. In camping terms, God is our tent, and we are putting our confidence in Him to protect and lead us.



On our way to the US Center for World Missions in Pasadena, where we will spend a couple of months, we plan to go via some of the National Parks. (That was the reason I was looking at the equipment.) During that time we look forward to special times of communion with the Lord and meditation on His Word. As we spend time with God and others whom God puts into our paths

we will use the Bible to be **"our compass"**. We do not want to " lean on our own understanding". It is so easy to believe our own limited understanding of situations is enough, and miss God's big picture of what He is doing. We long to hear from Him in a fresh way.

It was God that called us into missionary service and we want Him to lead us to the next phase. As the verse says, "Trust in the Lord. and He will direct your paths." So we know that he is "our map", or our GPS, to guide us to the next point of service. At this point we are convinced that our next assignment will be related to using our experience and passion for church planting in Europe in the areas of training, consulting, mentoring, member care and coaching. We are developing the concept of a resource center for church planters that will provide these services throughout Europe and maybe even to other continents.

We are confident that the Lord will lead us in the next steps as we recognize Him as our tent, our compass and our map. We are aware that we may encounter a "bear" or two and may experience some difficult times, so we ask you to keep praying for us at this critical time.

Just to clarify- we have our return tickets to Madrid, Spain for January 14th where we will continue serving with European Christian Mission International. We live in Spain and minister throughout Europe. Brenda plans to continue in prison ministry and as Coordinator of Member Care for ECMI.
