## KNOW BY HEART

hen I was in school (back in the Middle Ages), memorization was a big part of learning. In elementary school we had to memorize everything from multiplication tables to poetry. As I entered high school, we had to memorize a soliloquy from one of Shakespeare's plays for English Lit class. In my first year of high school French we had to memorize entire dialogues (we didn't use textbooks!)

In Sunday School, we were encouraged to memorize portions of scripture. That was how I 'earned' my first Bible. In all these instances, I was told to 'know it by heart.' That made me start thinking; what does it mean to know something 'by heart'? The dictionary of idioms states that it means to know something perfectly.

That is how God knows us; perfectly, completely. No one else can really know us 'by heart' as God does. No one else can know our hearts as God does. Our goal in life then should be to know our Lord 'by heart' and make our hearts perfectly in tune with His. The closer we walk with our Heavenly Father, the more like Him we strive to be, the more we will know Him 'by heart.'
