Rev. Joe & Wendy Toy, Jr.

oe and Wendy Toy are missionaries who work in Philadelphia and other areas, sharing the gospel on the streets. Joe has been doing open air ministry for over 32 years, beginning in Reading and now mainly working in the Philadelphia area.

Joe's schedule includes sharing the gospel to the homeless in Camden, NJ. He not only preaches God's word, but offers books, tracts, and Bibles. In the winter, he often shares hats or gloves. Because of his presence, God has raised some other men from Camden to work with him there.

During the school year, Joe will often visit universities including Temple, University of Penn, Kutztown, University of Delaware and others.



Joe also shares the gospel every Thursday afternoon in the Olney section of Philadelphia. He, the pastor of Olney Baptist church, plus a few others, help share the gospel near the transportation center. On Fridays you'll find Joe at an abortion clinic in New Jersey, standing up for the innocent ones who have no voice. On Friday afternoon Joe goes to 69th Street in Upper Darby to work with a small church in Yeadon that is doing outreach weekly.

Along with this work, Joe does event outreaches. These include Mardi Gras, Florida Winter Break, Super Bowl (some years), Indy 500, and a few weeks of summer outreach at the shore. The summer also has him helping with training various youth groups at the beach. Last fall there was an outreach in London, England with Sports Fan Outreach International to share the gospel at the World Athletic Competition. Adam (the youngest son) was stationed in England, so he was able to join Joe in that week.

Open Air Ministries also has projects that can involve churches. Each summer there has been a Back to School "school supplies" outreach where school supplies are collected by churches, then used by Joe in outreaches to the children in the city. Each fall there is a "stockings outreach" in which people will fill Christmas stockings with various items to give out at a "kids' meeting" in December. Church teams have also come to help give out the stockings and other cold weather items at these kids' meetings. The third project is the Bible project. People will collect old Bibles and donate them to Joe. These are the ones he puts out on the table in Camden to give away to anyone who wants God's word.

Wendy has helped with various administrative tasks for the ministry, along with home-schooling all the boys through high school. She had taught part time for seven years, and now works at the church they attend in Upper Darby, PA.

Joe and Wendy have five sons, two daughters-in-law, and six grandchildren.
