than was a recently retired father and grandfather. He had always been active; running, walking with his wife, and bicycling. He also was very careful about his diet; he only ate organic fruits and vegetables, free range chicken, and limited red meat.

So it was quite a shock when, one sunny fall day, Ethan felt something was very wrong as he was doing his daily walk. He asked his wife to take him to the local ER. As it turned out, Ethan was having a heart attack. All four of his arteries had serious blockages. He was prepped for surgery and had stents put in.

After several days, Ethan seemed to be doing well and was sent home to recuperate. He was fine for a while, but then started feeling very ill again. He went back to the hospital and they determined there was fluid in the sac around the heart. This was drained and Ethan was kept several days to recuperate as he was monitored. He was sent home once again, but the infection returned.

This time, Ethan's doctors sent him to another hospital known for their cardiac unit. The doctors there gave Ethan the bad news; his heart was not functioning properly. They could keep trying to stem the infections, but eventually these measures would not be enough. Ethan needed a new heart.

It would have been easy for Ethan and his family to be bitter towards God about this turn of events. He had always taken care of himself; why did this happen to him?! But Ethan and his family are believers; they have sought God's will in this matter and accepted it. Ethan has been a testimony to all around him during this entire situation; allowing God to show His grace to others through Ethan.

As I write this, Ethan is still waiting for his new heart. His friends and family are praying one is available soon, while at the same time knowing that means another family will deal with the pain of losing a loved one. It's a difficult situation.

God determined that the only way for humankind to be reestablished in a loving relationship with him was if they received new hearts. And he asked his only Son to be the donor. As we travel through this season of Lent, let us think about the price paid for us, and bow down in wonder and praise as we celebrate a God who loves us so much.
