guarantees some religious freedom. People can choose their faith, but it is illegal to convert others. An isolated mountainous land, containing 8 of the 10 highest mountains in the world, Nepal is just slightly larger than Pennsylvania and New Jersey combined. The 27,000,000 people represent approximately 95 people groups; however, caste is more crucial socially than ethnicity. The capital city, Katmandu has 1,500,000 people.

The Evangelical Congregational Church of India began the E.C. mission outreach to eastern Nepal resulting in the planting of ten churches. We officially inaugurated the E.C. Church of Nepal in June, 2003. In June of that year the churches elected a leadership team of five people to lead this new conference of the E.C. Church, and a church center was established at Dharan, in eastern Nepal. In January 2009 the E.C. church of Nepal became its own international conference. The Director is Rev. Th. Janga.

This past January the first graduation of ministry leaders from the Evangelical Leadership Training Course was held, as well as the dedication of the official ECCN Youth Department. Young people make up a significant portion of our EC churches in Nepal; a good sign for the next generation of leadership. Last year (2018) they had 108 converts, 87 new baptisms, established two more churches for a total of 12, and have 10 fellowships (church plants.) Rev. Janga's goals are to establish five more local churches this year.

In addition to the churches, ECCN has a ministry to orphans called Mercy Home, in honor of Rev. Janga's wife Mercy, herself an orphan as a child. Please uphold these brothers and sisters in Christ in prayer and consider assisting them financially through GMC.
