

Liberia



In January of this year, a new bishop was elected, Rev. Abraham Powell. Rev. Powel has been working on orienting his new leadership team; he has also conducted a comprehensive tour of the EC churches to assess the spiritual, physical, and emotional needs following the Ebola crisis.

One of the perceived needs is a children's camp, where they can be taught Christian values. You may recall that our 2014 VBS project was to raise funds for this, but in light of the Ebola crisis we used the camp funds for our Ebola response.

Another project is to develop a literacy program. The scriptures have been translated into the Bassa language, which is the tribe to which most of our EC church members belong, but due to the 14 years of civil war that totally disrupted their lives, many people can't read; the schools were closed most of that time. Rev. Powell wants to train the people to read by using the Bassa bible.

We give praise that three refurbished laptops and a video projector were donated to help with the literacy program. Rev. Henry Dennis, part of the EC leadership team, was in the USA for business and was able to hand carry the computers and projector back to Liberia, since it is unlikely that these items would have arrived safely if shipped.

Global Ministries is trying to raise the funds to purchase at least two motorcycles for pastors who live in remote areas to use to get around. Many of our churches are located in 'the bush' or jungle, with no passable roads, and hours from any road. Pastors need dirt bikes to be able to get around. The cost is approximately \$3000 per bike. Perhaps your Sunday School class or church would want to take on this project.



God continues to move in this west African country that has seen so much death and destruction in the past few decades. Please keep Rev. Powell and his leadership team in prayer as they seek God's will to expand His kingdom.
