# OUR MISSIONARY FAMILY

- **Jamie and Anita Farr:** We currently are walking through an insurance battle to cover the cost of repairing our roof which has a couple of leaks in it. We are trying to get the roof repaired. Pray for schooling for the four kids as they each face different challenges in education and schooling options during this season. Pray for Anita as she moderates and manages the schooling and many of the unique challenges that result with running the social engagements during a pandemic. Jamie leads a number of teams as VP of Planning, Staffing and Development for Wycliffe USA. His teams are going through a comprehensive review process to determine how to better serve internal and external customers. Leading and sending people in a COVID world requires both receiving partners and those preparing for service to adjust. Pray for wisdom on both sides of this challenging pandemic.

- **Beth Grimm:** pray for the missionary kid (MK) families who have struggling students who are not receiving the type of intervention they need in their MK schools due to well-trained staff shortages.

- **Prayer for travel:** for missionary families who are trying to travel to and from the field with many of their normal travel routes closed due to COVID restrictions and/or testing/vaccination requirements.

- **Ed and Valerie Schubert:** COVID-19 has brought wide-spread hunger to Honduras. Double hurricanes, Eta and Iota, brought further devastation and desperation when they slammed into Honduras two months ago. To combat malnutrition and starvation, we are currently heavily engaged in Food Distribution Outreaches to infants, children, teens, families and elderly members of our community who are at risk for hunger. Between March 30th and December 18th of 2020, we provided generous amounts of emergency food provisions for 14,374 hungry people! We continue to provide these emergency food staples and hurricane relief. Prayer for continued and increased support to continue to meet this overwhelming demand.

- **Missionary Speaking Engagements:** With travel restrictions many plans for international missionaries to be on furlough in the states are tentative. But, many are very eager to share and speak - and are coming up with very creative ways to do so. Reach out directly to them or contact the GMC office for more information.
